VIRTUAL CONFERENCE PLATFORM

We will be using a virtual conference platform called the Meeting Center. This platform will allow you to interact with other participants, exhibitors, and the planning committee. As we get a little closer to the date of the event, you will receive an email from event@meetingcenter.online with your login information.

This information is unique to you so please do not share your email. Once you receive the email, you are welcome to log in any time before the event to check out the platform and make sure everything works. CONTINUING EDUCATION
